SAT COURSES

College Edge offers SAT courses year round. Classes meet twice a week, and practice tests are given on Saturdays. We limit enrollment to 15 students allowing for quality interaction and exchange between instructors and students.

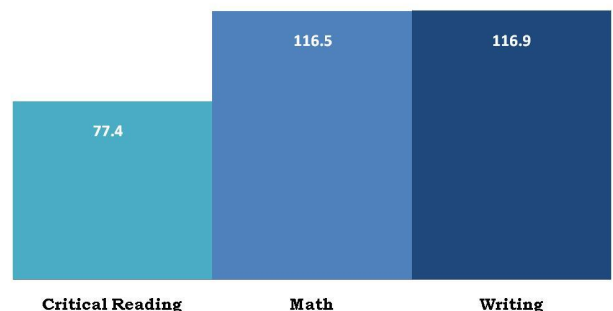

For the student who is unfamiliar with taking standardized tests, it will not only provide them with key methods and skills to perform well on the PSAT but also begin to solidly prepare them in the standard operations presented on these types of tests. As a supplement to our SAT courses, the ACT courses focus on the differences students will encounter on the ACT versus the SAT as well as specific strategies for performing well on the ACT. The ACT houses a Scientific Reasoning component not included on the SAT. This course includes nine hours and one practice ACT. (\$299.00)

ACT PRIVATE TUTORIAL NINE HOURS + 1 PRACTICE ACT

Individual preparation is also available for the ACT. One-on-one instruction provides the attention students require in specific subject areas concentrating on strategies unique to the ACT. This tutorial includes nine one-on-one hours and one practice ACT. (\$799.00)

THE SAT /ACT HYBRID SAT OR ACT COURSE + 4 PRIVATE TUTORING HOURS
